

Nord-Kivu : Caritas Congo Asbl assists the Diocesans Caritas in the implementation of projects

Butembo, April 18, 2017 (caritasdev.cd): The 2nd Assistant Executive Secretary of Caritas Congo Asbl responsible for program quality, Mr Boniface NAKWAGELEWI at DEAGBO, returns from a technical accompaniment mission of Caritas Diocesan Development in the Implementation of their projects. This time, the beneficiaries of this accompaniment were the Caritas diocesan of Goma and Butembo-Béni, in North Kivu in DRC. It took place respectively in Goma and Butembo, from 19 to 26 March 2017.

Projects and operation of Caritas Goma and Butembo-Beni analyzed

This mission allowed him to realize the progress of the projects that are carried out in the said dioceses. Indeed, it has made it possible to achieve the following results: the evolution of the implementation of the projects in the two Dioceses is known. Lessons learned and difficulties encountered in project implementation are shared, recommendations for further implementation of the projects are formulated.

Specifically, the 2nd Secretary of Caritas Congo Asbl noted that the two diocesan Caritas visited from its national network are working well. They also have the capacity to meet the actors on the ground whenever there is a request. The only difference between the two lies in the integration of their Services.

Caritas-Development Goma, Diocesan Office of Caritas / BDC (Emergencies and Social), the Diocesan Development Office (BDD) and the Diocesan Bureau of Medical Works (BDOM), including even the Diocesan Justice and Peace Commission (CDJP) are all integrated under the same coordination. This is not the case for Caritas-Development Butembo-Beni, whose integration process has already begun.

Thus, Caritas Congo Asbl exhorts Caritas Butembo-Béni to follow the example of Caritas Goma. Mister Boniface NAKWAGELEWI at DEAGBO also asked the two diocesan Caritas to retain and manage all that they reap for the good advancement of the work. Being members of the Caritas Congo Asbl network, he reminded them the need to work together effectively in favor of the most deprived for the functioning of this work of Christ.

As a reminder, the mission of the 2nd Assistant Executive Secretary was to accompany the two Caritas Diocesan Development in the implementation of the programs / projects and to support them on several levels. For the record, Caritas Congo Asbl plays the roles of capacity building for Caritas-Diocesan Development, advocacy and mobilization of resources for a more efficient Caritas national network serving the poor.

At present, Caritas Congo Asbl supports the diocesan Caritas of Goma and Butembo-Béni in various projects. These include projects to combat tuberculosis, combat HIV / AIDS, combat sexual violence, and empower women, including the project to improve

the quality of education, technical support for ex-combatants and the construction of a youth reintegration center. These programs are financed by different donors with beneficiaries all the population residing in the Dioceses of Goma and Butembo-Béni.
